



2009 Alaska World Affairs Council (AWAC) Student Scholarship Award

Do you know a Student who does or has done any of the following? If yes, NOMINATE HIM/HER for the annual AWAC Student Scholarship. The Alaska World Affairs Council will award up to three scholarships this year (\$1000 gold, \$500 silver and \$250 bronze) to Alaskan high school student(s). Alaska World Affairs Council Outstanding Student Award recipients are chosen based on these criteria:

Student has a keen interest in world affairs and is considering a degree program in this area.

Student promotes democratic citizenship.

Student is interested in considering a wide spectrum of viewpoints.

Student facilitates building people-to-people ties.

Student has done language study and demonstrates cross-cultural understanding.

Student participates in AWAC luncheons, student World Quest, or U.N. simulations.

Student has participated in world language festivals and events.

Student has participated in travel programs to other countries.

Note: Any high school student nominated for the scholarship who is not a senior, will have their nomination rolled over for consideration a second year if not selected the first year

Nomination Procedures

Nomination must be submitted electronically (send as an attachments to your email) to: lise.falskow@alaskaworldaffairs.org

Nomination should be submitted on or before **April 17, 2009**. The nomination packet should be no more than 5 pages in length and should include the following:

1. The nomination form
2. At least **ONE** supporting material for the nomination, such as
 - a) resume of nominee
 - b) letter of support for nominee
 - c) articles about nominee or articles published by nominee
 - f) information about activities done by nominee including mentoring other students, editing newsletters, etc.
 - g) information about other honors and awards received by nominee

Three board members from the Student Programs committee will read each nomination packet and make the final choice for the award. The winner (and the nominator) will be invited to an AWAC event in the month of May for the award presentation (date TBA).
